

HOW TO ACCESS THE TERMOLI REHABILITATION CLINIC

The Termoli Outpatient Clinic provides neurological, psychomotor and speech therapy rehabilitation services to patients of all age groups. Treatments last a minimum of 60 minutes per session.

Outpatient rehabilitation can be accessed by patients of any age, with less significant disabilities than in the home-based system.

According to the Guidelines of the Molise Regional Health Agency (ASREM), the type of rehabilitation interventions, access and duration must be established by the Branch Specialist of the Public Facility or of the accredited private Rehabilitation Centre for all outpatient and home rehabilitation services, to which the citizen turns, at the request of the General Practitioner GP or Free Choice Paediatrician PLS. The specialist of reference for the specific disability will follow the guidelines of the aforementioned document, using a special specialist assessment form prepared and called Form C which can be found on the ASREM website (www.asrem.gov.it) under the heading: MODULISTICS - REHABILITATIVE SERVICES. In accordance with the indications of the ASREM, the patient contacts, through his own General Practitioner/Pediatrician of Free Choice, the branch specialist of the ASL, and on the basis of a specific diagnosis, the request is evaluated by the Multidimensional Assessment Unit (UVM), which, if the conditions are met, authorises the treatment in accordance with a specific diagnosis and treatment plan, and this information is sent to the accredited facilities for taking charge.

The Termoli Outpatient Clinic Contact Person receives these reports and, if there is availability, starts the request for assessment by the Unified Acceptance Service, which can start taking charge of the patient or, if there is no availability, places him on the Waiting List. If taking charge is possible, the patient is contacted by telephone by the Unified Acceptance Service and summoned on the date and day at the Outpatient Clinic for the first visit. On the occasion of the first visit, by a Specialist Doctor, the Outpatient File is opened and the multidisciplinary assessment is started for the definition of the Individual Rehabilitation Project.

The patient is assessed from the moment he/she is taken on to define, using suitable assessment scales, the type of rehabilitation required, an individualised plan aimed at recovering or maintaining the individual's psychophysical abilities. This plan is defined with the multidisciplinary participation of various professionals assembled in teams that guarantee a multifactorial assessment for a correct diagnostic and rehabilitation framework.

Any extensions to the treatment initially defined, where the conditions are met, must be authorised with a similar procedure to the first acceptance, through recourse to the Multidimensional Assessment Unit.
